The Challenge

Boeing was faced with a typical challenge when preparing to package applications – different sets of applications were required for different groups across a large number of user's desktops. In addition, much of the source media needed to re-package the applications was missing. Initially, they hired a well-known consulting firm to package and deploy the applications. After 3 months, the project was off-track and in danger of being dissolved resulting in a contract termination.

The Solution

The original packaging vendor hired ISD to replace their own existing resources and get the project back on track. ISD provided a project manager and three dedicated application packagers who were able to introduce Reverse Engineering to deal with the challenge of not having the original source media. Through the use of this proprietary solution, ISD packaged over 100 applications.
